





Description

The following Instructions are used for inserting the 2 by 3 connector into a PCB.


Operation

- 1. Place a connector assembly on the PCB.
- 2. Place the tool on the connector assembly (closed end to the back end of the connector). See Figure 2.
- 3. Place tool, connector, and PCB, in a press of suitable size and force, and seat the connector assembly as shown. The support plate (furnished by the customer) under the PCB must have clearance for the connector pins as they pass through the PCB.



Clearance

Use this tool only with a press that has a pre-determined shut height when seating a QSFP Assembly on a PCB. See figure 3. Allowing the Press-In Tool to stop on the board will result in damage the QSFP cage and terminals being over seated.
