




## LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature




## Continuous load current vs. Ambient temperature




## LED forward current vs. LED forward voltage




## Continuous load current vs. On-state voltage




On-state resistance vs. Ambient temperature




Trigger LED forward current vs. Ambient temperature




Turn ON, Turn OFF time vs. LED forward current

Current leakage vs. Ambient temperature

















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


#### PCB Dimensions (BOTTOM VIEW)
