
- Frequency aging is the change in $f_{\rm C}$ with time and is specified at +65 $^{\circ}{\rm C}$ or less. Aging
- may exceed the specification for prolonged temperatures above +65 °C. Typically, aging is greatest the first year after manufacture, decreasing in subsequent years. The center frequency, f_C , is measured at the minimum insertion loss point, IL_{MIN} , with the resonator in the 50 Ω test system (VSWR \leq 1.2:1). The shunt inductance, L_{TEST} , is tuned for parallel resonance with C_O at f_C . Typically, $f_{OSCILLATOR}$ or $f_{TRANSMITTER}$ is approximately equal to the presenter for 2 approximately equal to the resonator f_{C} .

Electrical Connections


The SAW resonator is bidirectional and may be installed with either orientation. The two terminals are interchangeable and unnumbered. The callout NC indicates no internal connection. The NC pads assist with mechanical positioning and stability. External grounding of the NC pads is recommended to help reduce parasitic capacitance in the circuit.












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Case and Typical PCB Land Dimensions



Equivalent RLC Model




Temperature Characteristics

The curve shown accounts for resonator contribution only and does not include external LC component temperature effects.




Characterization Test Circuit
