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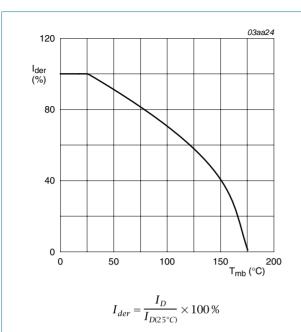


Fig 1. Normalized continuous drain current as a function of mounting base temperature

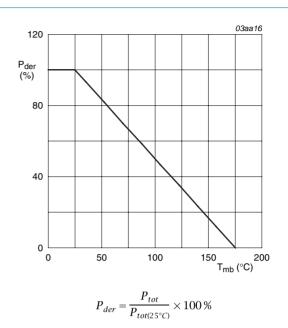
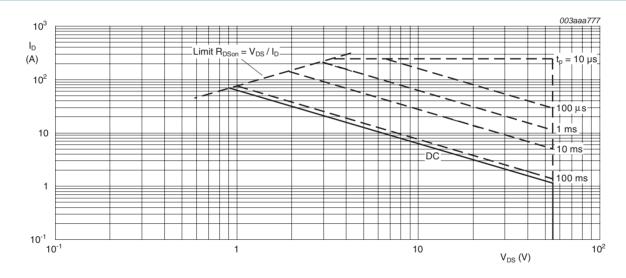


Fig 2. Normalized total power dissipation as a function of mounting base temperature



 $T_{mb} = 25$ °C;  $I_{DM}$  is single pulse

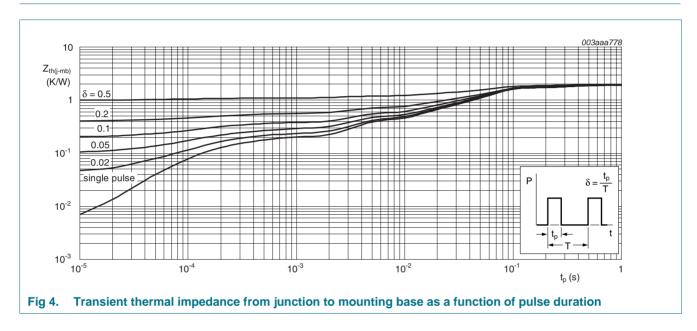
Fig 3. Safe operating area; continuous and peak drain currents as a function of drain-source voltage

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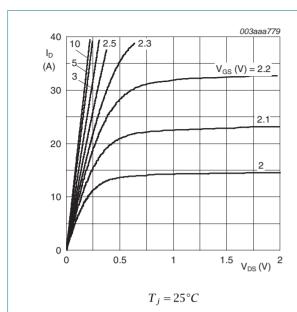
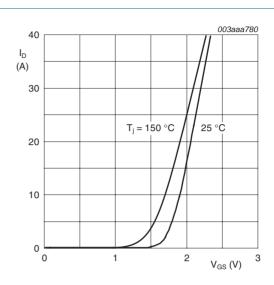


Fig 5. Output characteristics: drain current as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

Fig 6. Transfer characteristics: drain current as a function of gate-source voltage; typical values

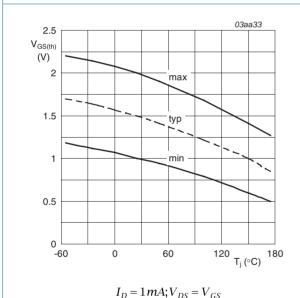


Fig 7. Gate-source threshold voltage as a function of junction temperature

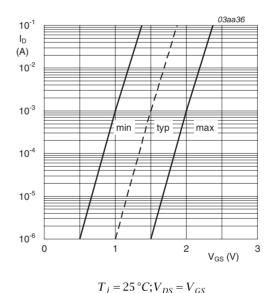


Fig 8. Sub-threshold drain current as a function of gate-source voltage

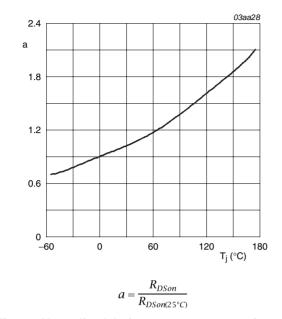
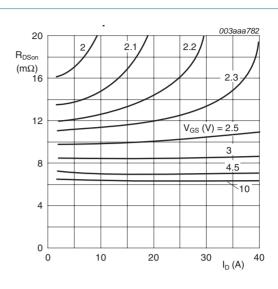
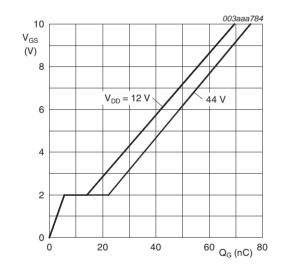


Fig 9. Normalized drain-source on-state resistance factor as a function of junction temperature

 $I_D = 25A; V_{DS} = 12V \, {\rm and} \, 44V$  Fig 11. Gate-source voltage as a function of gate

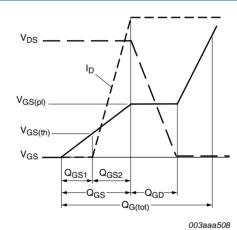


Fig 12. Gate charge waveform definitions

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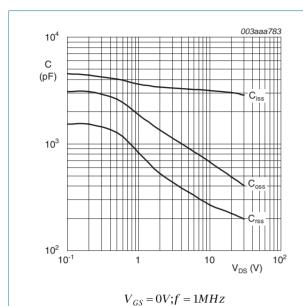
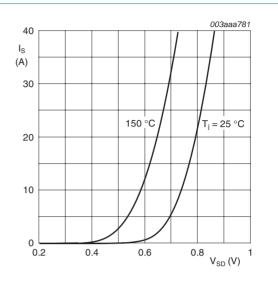


Fig 13. Input, output and reverse transfer capacitances as a function of drain-source voltage; typical values

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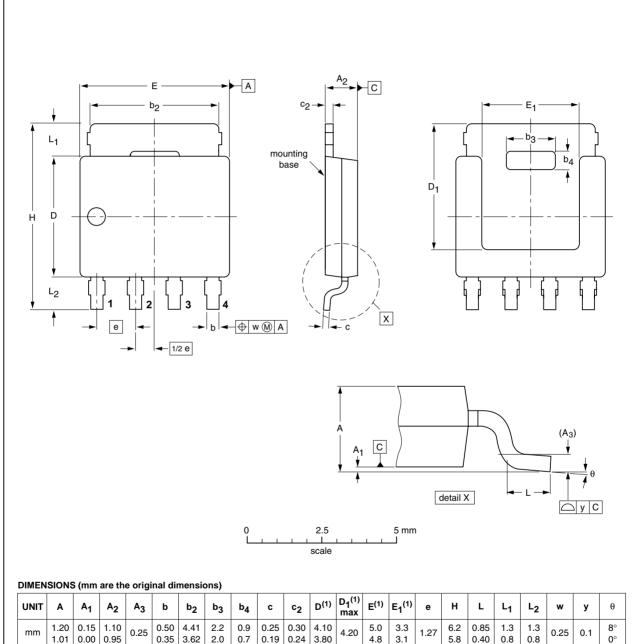
Fig 14. Source current as a function of source-drain voltage; typical values
